This tournament is in the memory of Mike Rawiri a long standing club member and administrator of Arataki.

Thank you for your interest and enjoying us for a fun day of Preseason Rugby.

LAWS OF THE TOURNAMENT

The Laws of this tournament will be played under the Laws of the Game of Rugby Football and adopted by the Arataki Sports Club Inc, with the following amendments;

1. **All matches** will be played and refereed under **NZRU Rules and Regulations**.
2. Team rosters shall comprise of **16 Players + Coach and Manager** and are to be declared prior to the start of the tournament. On field teams will consist of **10 Players** each in a **5 Forward** and **5 Back** split.
3. Substitutions are **Rolling subs**. Players may only be substituted during a stoppage of play (except during a penalty) and with the referees approval.
4. All Player **Substitutions** must adhere to assigned **marked** substitution Areas and technical zones. These areas are for **substitutions** and **team management only**
5. **Scrums** will consist of 5 players per team in a **3(Front Row) - 2(Back Row)** configuration
6. **Lineouts** will consist of **UP TO 4 PLAYERS** per team + **THROWER IN**. The throwing team dictates the number. Non-Throwing team must match up **excluding Thrower In**.
7. **All Kicks** are to be **DROP KICKS**, ie – Kick Offs, Penalties, Conversions. (Teams are not required to stand in goal for conversions.)
8. **Minimum** of 8 players required to start game. (2 minutes allowed after kick off to get full 10 on field.) Failure to do so will incur points penalty @ 2 points per minute thereafter. Game called off after 5 minutes if opposing team(s) are not on field after the hooter.
9. Once your registered playing roster reaches 13 (because of genuine injury to the other 3 registered players), you are able to recruit 2 other registered players from teams that have already been knocked out of the tournament and have no games remaining.



LAWS OF THE TOURNAMENT - Continued

10. All **RED CARD** incidents will, in the 1st instance, be recorded by the match official noting details of the incident, the involved player/s team/s, their jersey #/ s and their name/s.

Red Card players will not be replaced for the remainder of that match. The match official, the player/s involved and the player/s team manager/s will then, **immediately** after the conclusion of the match in which the incident occurred, be required to report to the “on the day Judicial Committee” for investigation.

The “on the day Judicial Committee” will consist of 2 members of the Arataki Sports Club Inc organising/management committee + match official + offending player/s & manager/s.

Under **LAW 26 NZRU Disciplinary Rules**, the match official, if he feels it is warranted, may forward the report on to the BOPRU for further action.

RED CARD players will take no further part in the tournament and will not be replaced in their team roster.

Referees and Touch Judges will be appointed by
Bay of Plenty Referees Association

ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY will be given for referee abuse from players, team officials and supporters.

11. The Laws of the Tournament, including their interpretation & any additional rules, are at the sole discretion of the tournament organisers from Arataki Sports Club whose decision shall be final.
12. Draw to be finalised at the Managers Meeting. (No changes once finalised.)
Draft draw emailed out on the Wednesday before tournament.



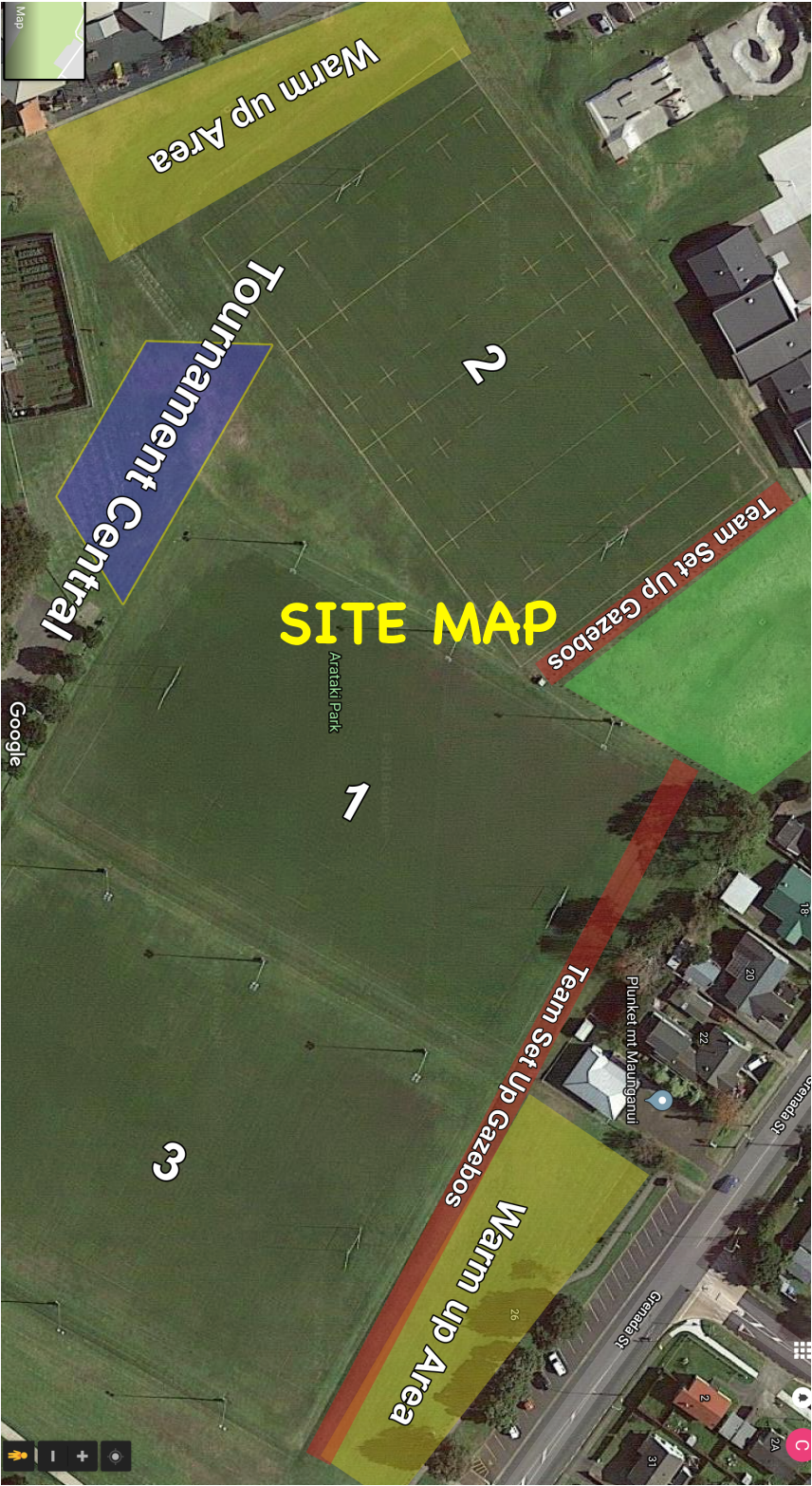
Tournament Rules

RULES OF THE TOURNAMENT:

13. Players must keep the same jersey number for the full duration of the tournament.
14. **Pool Games /Semi Finals – Duration** - 2 x 10 minute Halves with a 2 Minute Half time break.
15. **Pool Games** - In the event of a **Draw** after regulation time, the winning team will be adjudged the team that scored the first try in the game. If no tries, 1st penalty or field goal. If still no winner, toss of coin by referee.
16. **Championship Final** – Duration – 2 x 15 minute Halves with a 3 Minute Half time break.
17. **Semi Finals/Championship Final** – In the event of a Draw after regulation time, a **Golden Point/Drop Off system** will be implemented.
 - a) After a further 3 minute break, where both teams will revert to the half of the field they started the match on, the team who kicked off 1st will get proceedings underway again.
 - b) Both teams will endeavour to score the 1st (Golden) point, to hence, win the match.
 - c) Should, after a period of **2 minutes**, neither team score, each team will lose (**Drop Off**) a player from the field of play.
 - d) This will be repeated after each 2 minute period to a minimum of 6 on field players per team, (**3 man scrums will apply at 8 players per team**) at which point play will continue until a winner is established.
18. Match balls will be provided by the Arataki Sports Club Inc for the Semi-finals and Final.
